Revision - Paragraph 2.7 Concerning Basketball Backboard/Permanent Installation

**2.7 Basketball Backboards, Portable and Permanent Backboards.** ARC approval is required for every type of basketball goal installation. Garage mounted backboards may be considered for approval. Free standing, pole mounted backboards may be constructed in the "Front" yard subject to the following guidelines:

A Permanent Basketball Pole and properly mounted Backboard may be installed along side the driveway but may not be placed any closer than fifteen feet of the street sidewalk and no additional concrete pad may be constructed to accommodate the new Pole/Backboard installation. "Rear", "Side" and "Front" yard pole mounted basketball backboards may be approved based upon, but not limited to, the following conditions: proximity of the goal to the property lines, proximity of the goal to the neighbor's living area, proximity of the goal to the neighbor's landscaping and vehicles.

Portable freestanding basketball backboards may be conditionally approved if reasonably placed for play and properly stored when not in use.
